

The Friends of SGHS 150 Club

The 150 club is a great way for you to support the school whilst having a bit of a flutter! The primary beneficiary of the 150 Club will be the school's hardship fund, which helps students with school expenses they might otherwise not be able to afford.

Here is how the 150 Club works...

- You can buy one or more membership numbers for the 150 Club via parentpay or by completing the attached form and returning it with a cheque to the school's reception.
- Specific numbers can be requested but if these have already been allocated then the Friends' committee will allocate the next available number.
- The cost per membership number is £20 and each number will be entered into the monthly draw for 12 months.
- The draws will be from January to December.
- There will three winning numbers each month. 1st prize will be £40, 2nd prize £25, 3rd prize £10.
- If more than 150 membership number requests are received and purchased, there will be increased prizes, with the total prizes equating to 45% of the money received over the year.
- All participants must be over 16.

150 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 150 Club is to raise funds, with the primary beneficiary being the school's hardship fund. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account and used to meet funding requests from this fund, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

RULES

1. For a cost of £20 per year you will be allocated one number between 1 and 150 (or more, if more than 150 numbers are purchased).
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize of £40, £25 and £10, respectively.
3. If more than 150 membership number requests are received and purchased, there will be increased prizes, with the total prizes equating to 45% of the money received over the year.
4. All participants must be over 16.
5. The 150 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Skipton Girls' High School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
6. Payments can be made via parentpay or by cheque (left at reception).
7. Member's numbers will only be entered if the subscription is up to date.
8. If at renewal a member does not pay for their number within a month of the renewal request, their number may be sold to someone else.
9. The draw shall be made monthly by the Friends' committee with a representative of the school.
10. Winning cheques can either be collected from reception or posted to the address on your membership application.
11. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the school website.
12. The 150 Club will be run by the Friends of SGHS. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
13. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTFA funds after six months.
