Snacks and Lunches

All children are able to have milk during their session, we also have snacks including bagels, fruit, vegetables, breadsticks and crackers.

Full time children can have either a packed lunch or a school dinner. Please order all school dinners via Aspens.

All children need a named water bottle everyday.

In our Nursery we follow the In The Moment Planning approach, this means that we will observe the children to see what they are interested in and then plan activities to support these interests. During each term every child will have a focus week, where the staff spend extra time supporting their learning, at this time we will send home a parent sheet for you to fill in and return along with photographs from home. We really hope you will support your child's learning by doing this, having the photographs really helps the child to talk about their experiences outside of Nursery and helps the staff to know your child better. These photographs then form part of your child's Learning Journey book at Nursery.

Class Dojo

We will continue to use ClassDojo to communicate between Nursery and home. We will post regular photographs to keep you up to date with what is happening at Nursery. Once you are logged on as a parent, you then have the ability to message us should you have any questions/concerns. We know it is not always easy to speak at the gates when dropping off. We will reply as soon as possible. Please remember to report all absences to the office.

Our children have access to our outdoor area at all times. We always encourage them to wear our wellies and waterproofs during wet weather, however they will still come home dirty. We understand this can be frustrating but it really does mean they have been involved in lots of good learning opportunities. Please ensure your child has a change of clothes with them and that ALL items are named.
